### NARRATIVE

Detectives were assigned a financial crimes investigation, Sarasota Police Department case number 23-012067. Through the course of that investigation, allegations of possible animal abuse committed by the owner, Diana Stevens, were reported to Detectives. Three former employees of Woof Gang Bakery and Grooming Sarasota (1129 S. Tamiami Trail Sarasota, FL 34236) were interviewed in reference to the financial crimes' investigation (see case number 23-012067). The following information and evidence were provided.

Detectives interviewed witness #1 at the Sarasota Police Department, the following is a summary of the interview. Witness #1 is a former employee of Woof Gang Bakery and Grooming Sarasota. Witness #1 stated she was a groomer in the store along with Stevens and several other employees. Witness #1 stated he witnessed Stevens abuse animals she was grooming in the store. Stevens would smack and hit dogs, she was rough with cats and would hit them, she would jerk the cats around and flip them over and she would tether the cats while she groomed them, which is dangerous. Witness #1 stated tethering a cat could cause the cat's neck to break. Stevens would also grab the dogs by the scruff out of frustration and she was aggressive with them while she groomed them. Witness #1 stated some of the customers complained that their dogs were acting differently when they brought them home.

Additionally, Witness #1 stated Stevens and another employee, Witness #2, purchased numerous puppies to include French Bulldog puppies to sell. The French Bulldog puppies were kept at the shop, they were in a small kennel in unsanitary conditions by living in their own urine and feces. Witness #1 stated one of the French Bulldog puppies died, a tan male. The litter, to include the tan male, was left at the shop alone overnight and unsupervised in a sink/bathing tub. The French Bulldog puppy was discovered the next day unresponsive. Stevens placed the dog into a cardboard box and it was kept at the store for a while until Stevens did something with it. Witness #1 is unsure what happened to the puppy after that.

Detectives interviewed Witness #2, a former employee of Woof Gang Bakery and Grooming Sarasota. Witness #2 stated Stevens was abusive to animals she groomed and described four separate incidents:

1. Stevens was bathing a 75lb-80lb Tan Golden Doodle and the dog was being difficult. Stevens become upset when the dog didn't comply and she stated "this dog is a piece of shit," and then punched it with a closed fist several times in the ribs and abdomen. While punching the dog, Stevens was yelling "fuck you," to the Tan Golden Doodle. Witness #2 stated she intervened and later that night Stevens apologized in a text to Witness #2 about her behavior.

NARRATIVE CONTINUED

2. Stevens was going to bathe and groom a white Persian-Ragdoll cat and she became frustrated with the cat. Stevens began slinging the cat around, she got scratched by the cat and began shaking it. Stevens, then, grabbed the cat by the scruff and swung the cat into the wall. Witness #2 stated she intervened and took the cat from Stevens and she finished bathing and grooming the cat.

3. Stevens was going to bathe and groom an all black short hair Domesticated cat and the cat became difficult. Stevens grabbed the cat by the scruff and back and slammed it multiple times into the table. Stevens also grabbed the cat by its head and slammed the head into the table. Stevens continues to bath and groom the cat and smacks the cat several times. Eventually, Witness #4 intervenes and assists Stevens with the cat.

4. Witness #2 was told by another employee that another Doodle was misbehaving for Simmons while he was grooming it. Stevens walked over to the Doodle and Simmons and preceded to hit the dog.

Additionally, Stevens and Witness #2 purchased several French Bulldog puppies together and they were kept at the store. Stevens and Witness #2 left the French Bulldog puppies in a bathtub overnight because Stevens and Witness #2 believed it would be easier to clean them up in the morning. Kovacevic state she placed puppy pads in the bottom of the bathtub and then a metal crate over the puppy pads. Ester Velazquez, the mother of Stevens, came into the store the next morning and the tan male puppy was unresponsive. Velazquez called Witness #2 and told her the puppy died, Witness #2 stated she took the puppy to the vet for a necropsy.

On 08/21/2023 at 0940 hours, Detectives interviewed Witness #3 at the Sarasota Police Department, the following is a summary of the interview. Witness #3 is a former employee of Woof Gang Bakery and Grooming Sarasota. Witness #3 stated she was a groomer in the store along with Stevens and several other employees. Witness #3 stated while working there, she witnesses Stevens abuse the animals she groomed. Witness #3 stated one incident, Stevens was bathing a small red Doodle and it was afraid of the blow dryer. The red Doodle urinated on itself and therefore had to be washed again. Stevens became upset, she grabbed the dog by the scruff and threw it into the tub. Stevens rewashed the dog, grabbed it by the scruff again and threw it across the room onto the drying table. Stevens pinned the dog down and forced the blow dryer into the dog's face. The dog became so afraid, it defecated on itself and had to be washed again. At this point, an employee intervened and took over washing the dog because Stevens was getting aggressive with the dog.

### NARRATIVE CONTINUED

Witness #3 stated Stevens was abusive to cats as well. If a cat was not complying with being washed, Stevens would hit the cat and slam it into the table. Additionally, Stevens and Witness #2, purchased several French Bulldog puppies, Stevens kept them in the shop and she was planning on selling them. Stevens neglected the French Bulldog puppies, she was abusive and they were mistreated. Stevens kept the French Bulldog puppies in a small crate, they were not let out and were living in their urine and feces. Stevens would leave the French Bulldog puppies at the shop overnight as well. One of the French Bulldog puppies died, a tan male, when the litter was left overnight in the shop alone.

Detectives interviewed Witness #4, a former employee of Woof Gang Bakery and Grooming Sarasota. Witness #4 stated she was a groomer in the store along with Stevens and several other employees. In early 2023, Stevens and Witness #2, went to Georgia to purchase French Bulldog puppies to sell. Stevens and Witness #2 brought back 8-10 French Bulldog puppies with the intent to sell them for \$5,000 to \$12,000 each. Stevens and Witness #2 left the puppies at Woof Gang Bakery and Grooming Sarasota, and they were kept in a crate and never let out. Witness #2 and another employee would come in on the weekends to care of the puppies but during the week, Stevens would not take care of them. Witness #4 stated the puppies were being neglected by Stevens and were living in unsanitary and horrible conditions. Stevens would not clean or bathe the puppies, they lived in their own urine and fecal matter until one of the groomers would clean them. Witness #4 stated over a weekend, the puppies were left unattended and one of the French Bulldog puppies choked and died. The body was placed into a box and kept in the store until Stevens figured out what to do with it.

Witness #4 also stated Stevens was abusive to dogs and cats of customers she groomed. Stevens would get frustrated with the dogs and cats, she would grab the dogs by the scruff, jerk them around and she would regularly hit the dogs. Witness #4 stated Stevens was abusive to the animals.

Witness #1, Witness #2, Witness #3 and Witness #4 all stated there is video surveillance footage in the store, it records, and the data is kept at the store.

Detectives called Woof Gang Bakery and Grooming corporate office, located in Orlando, FL. Detectives spoke with an employee, who stated they had received several complaints from other employees of Stevens abusing animals that she was grooming.

Detectives obtained a signed search warrant for Woof Gang Bakery and Dog Grooming (1129 S. Tamiami Trail, Sarasota, FL. 34236). This was executed and Detectives collected digital video recorder, it was removed from the store and taken as evidence.

**NARRATIVE CONTINUED**

Detectives reviewed the video surveillance footage from Woof Gang Bakery and Grooming (1129 S. Tamiami Trail, Sarasota, FL 34236), the following was observed:

VICTIM #1-On 08/09/2023 at 0847 hours, Stevens is grooming an all-white cat at her grooming table. The cat has a grooming noose around its neck and it looks in distress. Stevens is attempting to shave the cat. Stevens grabs the cat by its neck and pins it to the table to shave its stomach area. Stevens gets fed up, she holds the cat by the side of its neck, removes the noose and is holding it over the ground by its neck. While holding the cat, Stevens picks up the pink carrier and forcefully throws the cat into the carrier. Stevens then grabs the tip of the cat's tail and pushes it into the carrier to then zip it closed.

-On 08/09/2023 at 1006 hours, Stevens is attempting to shave and groom the same all white cat while her employee holds the cat by the scruff. Stevens takes the cat from the employee and forcefully pushes it into the pink cat carrier. Then she zips up the carrier and brings the cat to the front lobby. The cat appears to be in distress.

VICTIM #2 -On 08/11/2023 at 0925 hours, Stevens is grooming a small white and tan dog with a long tail on her grooming table. The dog has a grooming noose around its neck and Stevens is shaving the dog. Stevens grabs the dog by the tail and lifts the dog up and off of its back legs by its tail in order to shave the dog. The dog appears to be in distress.

-On 08/11/2023 at 1100 hours, Stevens is grooming the same small white and tan dog on her grooming table. Stevens grabs the dog by the tail and forcefully pulls it and in the same motion spins the dog around. She then grabs the dog by its skin over its shoulder blades and continues to shave it. Stevens then grabs the dog by its front leg and forcefully pulls it towards her and slides it on the grooming table.

VICTIM #3- On 08/12/2023 at 0957 hours, Stevens removes a black and white cat from its carrier, places it on the grooming table and places a grooming noose around its neck. Stevens proceeds to shave the cat and redirects the cat by forcefully pulling on the noose.

### NARRATIVE CONTINUED

VICTIM #4- On 08/16/2023 at 1446 hours, Steven is shaving a small all white dog with long hair. Stevens grabs the dog by its face and pulls it upwards and towards her. The dog is in distress and cowers away in fear from Stevens, who then forcefully pulls the dog towards her again. The dog pulls away again and Stevens grabs the dog by its ears and yanks the dog's head. The dog pulls away in fear from Stevens and then she grabs the dog by its face, forcefully lifts its neck back and begins to shave the dog's chest. Stevens lets go of the dog and it is now standing on all fours on the table. Stevens begins to shave its back and then grabs the dog by the tail and forcefully pulls the dog towards her. The dog appears to be in distress. Stevens continues to hold the dog by the middle of its tail while she shaves it. Stevens then wraps the tail around on her hand and grabs onto the dog's back legs to groom it. Stevens jerks and pulls the dog by its tail and legs while she is grooming it. Stevens turns the dog around to face her by aggressively pulling its neck, the dog pulls away from her and then she grabs it by its ears, picks it up off the table and slams it back down. She then attempts to put the noose around its neck and the dog wiggles free. Stevens grabs the dog again by its neck, forcefully pulls it off its feet and attempts to get the noose back on its neck. She is unsuccessful and then pins the dog to the table by its neck. Stevens finally gets the noose around the dog's neck, tightens it all the way and then yanks the dog up by the noose. The dog is hanging by its neck in the air, she hits the dog twice and the dog spins around in the air. Stevens attaches the other end of the noose to the table. Stevens appears to be yelling at the dog and the dog appears to be fear. Stevens leaves the dog on the grooming table unattended and walks to the back of the room. She returns with wipes and proceeds to clean the counter and dog's rectum area due to the dog urinating on itself out of fear. Stevens continues to shave the dog by forcefully holding it down and pulling it in different directions by its limbs. Stevens aggressively pulls the dog towards her again by lifting it up off the table by the noose around its neck. The dog is in fear and distress.

VICTIM #5- On 08/17/2023 at 1109 hours, Stevens is grooming and shaving a medium sized all white dog, who has a blue muzzle on its face and the grooming noose around its neck. Stevens is attempting to cut its nails, the dog pulls away and Stevens gets upset. She pushes the dog around to face her, grabs the dog with both hands around its neck and proceeds to choke, shake and yells in the dog's face. The dog tried to get away, Stevens grabs the dog by its front legs and holds it down while she continues to yell at it. Stevens appears to tell her white male employee she cannot groom this dog while she is grabbing it by its back area. Stevens, then, pushes and smacks the dog and forces it to sit by pushing its back end down onto the table. The dog is in fear and distress.

### NARRATIVE CONTINUED

VICTIM #6- On 08/23/2023 at 1242 hours, Stevens is grooming a small white and gray dog with shaggy hair on her grooming table. The dog has the grooming noose around its neck. The dog places its front paws on Steven's chest area while she is brushing it, and she is holding it by the side of its neck. The dog pulls away from her slightly and she forcefully adjusts her grip on its neck, turns the dog and pulls its head backwards. Stevens is yelling at the dog while she is doing this. Stevens continues to brush the dog. Stevens then starts to cut the dog's nails, while she is doing this the dog's head it in the way of Steven's view of its paw. Stevens hits the dog in the face with the nail clippers, the dog is in distress and she pokes the dog in the face several more times with the clippers. Stevens continues to cut the nails, then lets the dog go, pushes it, then hits the dog on the top of its head while she is yelling at the dog. Stevens pulls the dog by its back leg and forcefully grabs its back leg to cut the nails.

The above occurred in the City of Sarasota, FL.
